## The 2019 Nellie Shelor Award

The award honors Nellie Shelor, a lifetime member of Calvary whose tireless and selfless service to God and this community through our church inspired the creation of an annual award to be named for her and presented to her as the first recipient. The award consists of a certificate to be presented to the honoree during one of the regular Sunday worship services and the placing of the honoree's name alongside previous winners on the perpetual award plaque in the narthex. The Lay Leadership Committee (LLC) will select the recipient annually.

## Nomination Process

Nomination forms, are on the table in the Narthex (which includes the criteria to be considered for the award) This will not be an election, but an attempt to give LLC the benefit of the congregations input. The person mentioned on the most nomination forms will not necessarily be the award recipient. That decision rests with LLC:

- · Deadline for forms to be returned is January 17, 2020;
- No more than one name can be put into nomination on any form;
- Nomination form will include:
  - Name of person making nomination
  - Nominee
  - Brief reason why this person deserves this award

Once chosen, the name of the honoree will be kept in confidence until award is presented on a Sunday to be determined according the church calendar and the recipient's availability.
